

RULES/ REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE USE OF PARKS AND PLAYGROUNDS

1. Regular activities shall always have priority on the use of facilities.
2. No persons, organizations or groups shall have the use of Parks/Playgrounds for other than normal activities, without the prior filing of an application for approval by the Superintendent of Public Works or his designee. The Superintendent (or designee) shall advise the Board of Selectmen of the application so as knowledge of the requested activity will be known and should the Board determine that said activity would not be in the best interest of the town, no approval shall be granted.
3. No use of Parks or Playgrounds by outside groups shall interfere with the normal activities of the property.
4. Whenever it may be deemed necessary to close the fields due to inclement weather or any other reason, it shall be at the discretion of the Public Works Superintendent (or designee).
5. All persons, organizations or groups granted the use of Parks or Playgrounds, shall provide adequate protection against injuries and property. Adequate protection shall include the necessary number of adults to provide supervision whenever children are a part of the activity or audience. Such persons, organizations or groups shall be responsible for any damage done or injuries occurring. Insurance coverage certificate may be required.
6. There shall be a Public Works employee on duty if so determined by the Superintendent, with payment being the responsibility of the person's, organization or group.
7. The Parks or Playgrounds are not available between November 1st and May 1st for other than normal activities, unless otherwise duly authorized.
8. All alcoholic beverages are forbidden, unless a special license has been used by the Board of Selectman.
9. The Chief of Police assigns police coverage whenever he may deem it necessary. Payment to the officers shall be the responsibility of the applicant.
10. The Public Works Department shall supply the proper containers for the control and disposal of trash and debris.
11. Upon completion of activities, it shall be the responsibility of the persons, organizations or groups to clean area and place all debris in containers.
12. No items, vehicles, motorized equipment, trailers, or motorbikes, shall be allowed on playing fields or any other area unless authorized.
13. Paved parking areas shall be utilized for parking of vehicles only.
14. Any violations of these Rules and Regulations may be cause for revocation of permit.
