October 7th—Last day to designate Early Voting site(s)

Please keep in mind that even though this is the official deadline for when you must designate the location(s) and times of your Early Voting site(s), it is recommended that you do it before this period, especially if you would like someone from the State Elections Division to give you some feedback on the location(s) before you designate it.

October 17th—FIRST Deadline to publish Location, Dates, and Times of Early Voting site(s)

Please note that this is only the first deadline for, "...the registrars for each city or town [to] publish the location of the early voting sites as well as the applicable dates and hours." The locations, dates, and hours shall also be published, "...at least once during the voting period." The notice shall be, "...published in every newspaper listed for the city or town in the New England Newspaper & Press Association and shall also be conspicuously posted in the office of the city clerk or on the principal official bulletin board of each city or town, on any other public building considered necessary, on the city or town's website, if any, and on the website of the state secretary." MGL Ch. 54 Sec. 25B

November 4th—Early Voting Ends

Early Voting **IN PERSON** ends at the **CLOSE OF BUSINESS OF CITY OR TOWN HALL** on Friday, November 4th.

Early Voting **BY MAIL** ends at **NOON (12:00pm)** on Friday, November 4th. The application must be received by your office by noon.

- **Question 1** would allow the Gaming Commission to issue an **additional slots license**.
- **Question 2** would authorize the approval of up to **12 new charter schools**, or enrollment expansions in existing charter schools by the state Board of Elementary & Secondary Education per year.
- **Question 3** would prohibit certain methods of **farm animal containment**.
- **Question 4** would **legalize recreational marijuana** for individuals at least 21 years old.

The meeting will also include information on the **Millionaire's Tax** as well as the distribution of **AIM's Legislative Scorecard**.
