PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE
CONTINUATION OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Board of Selectmen will **continue** the public hearing on the **Eversource Energy – Walpole to Holbrook 115-kV Reliability Project**, which was originally opened on Wednesday, March 8, 2017. The continued hearing will begin at 7:20 p.m. on Wednesday, March 22, 2017 in the Selectman Noel C. King Meeting Room, Floor 3R, Town Hall, 50 North Franklin Street, Holbrook, to discuss the Project, summarized below, and to hear comments from the public. All interested parties are encouraged to attend.

NStar Electric Company d/b/a Eversource Energy has submitted a Grant of Location Petition pursuant to the Company's plans to install a third 115-kV line within the existing Right-of-way on existing line towers between the Towns of Walpole and Holbrook. The new line will be strung on the open (vacant) side of the existing towers that are currently carrying a single 345-kV line between Walpole and Holbrook.

Within the Town of Holbrook, this project proposes to add a new 115-kV transmission line on the vacant side of these existing towers between Centre Street and the existing Holbrook Substation. The Project therefore requires the aerial crossing of the following roadways within the Town of Holbrook:

- North Franklin Street (Route 37) – MassDOT Jurisdiction
- Centre Street
- Scott Street
- Westdale Road
- Damon Avenue
- Pine Street
