



**HAZARDOUS WASTE DAY**  
**Saturday, December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2012**  
**9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.**  
**Holbrook Jr./Sr. High School**

The Town of Holbrook will be holding a hazardous waste and "e-cycle" day on Saturday, December 1, 2012 from 9 AM to 12 noon in the Holbrook Jr. High / Sr. High School complex. The Board of Health and the Holbrook DPW are working together with Clean Ventures, Inc and Backstop Technologies, a local Holbrook firm to dispose of hazardous wastes and recycle unused electronics.

The collection point at the Jr. / Sr. High School will accept electronics including old computers, office equipment, cables, small appliances, fax machines, cell phones and other small electrical items. Included in the hazardous waste disposal will be old cans of oil based paint (no latex paint accepted), herbicides, pesticides, waste oil (no commercial disposal accepted as this collection is intended for private households), antifreeze and most products sold in aerosol cans. Also batteries of most types, fluorescent bulbs and mercury will be accepted.

Not being accepted at the event are propane tanks, latex paint, radioactive products, explosives, PCB's, and infectious or gaseous waste. The town and the vendors will reserve the right not to accept any items that present a danger to those working the event. Televisions and computer monitors will be accepted with a \$ 25 fee payable to the Town of Holbrook.

Residents with questions may call the Holbrook Board of Health at 781-767-3030. Residents may note that it is best to arrive early as the town has set aside a sum of money for disposal of materials and may close down prior to noon if the funds are spent before noon time.

Event organizers will have an area set up to accept donations for several local food pantries as well so non-perishable food items are encouraged.
